

## Facts, Statistics and Taxes



### Geography

The community of Sevelen is situated in the Canton of St. Gallen in the Werdenberg region. The community also encompasses the hamlets of Rans/Oberräfis, St. Ulrich and Sevelerberg. The community lies on the eastern slopes of the Alvier mountain chain, on the opposite bank of the Rhine from the Liechtenstein capital of Vaduz. It extends to the peak of the Fulfirst mountain at 2,383 metres, where it borders the community of Walenstadt. In the valley, the Rhine marks the border of Sevelen, where it reaches its lowest point at 451 metres. In total, the community covers an area of 30.34 km<sup>2</sup>.
